

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**  
**2011 Spring Loaded Viewers Competition**

1. Entry into this competition deems acceptance of these Terms and Conditions of entry. Entries that do not comply with these Terms and Conditions or entries that are late, lost, misdirected, incomplete, indecipherable or illegible entries will be deemed invalid and NZRB takes no responsibility for such entries. All entries will remain the property of NZRB.
2. The competition opens at 8pm on Wednesday 5 October 2011 and closes at 5pm on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2011 (the **Competition Period**). All entries must be received during the Competition Period.
3. To be eligible to enter this competition, customers must; Watch Spring Loaded on Trackside on any Wednesday in the competition period and correctly answer the Viewer Question asked for that week and email answer and contact details to [tracksidecompetitions@tab.co.nz](mailto:tracksidecompetitions@tab.co.nz).
4. Each customer may make one entry per week up to a total of 4 entries during the Competition Period.
5. Board members, employees, agents (and agents' employees) and contractors of the New Zealand Racing Board (**NZRB**) and the Immediate Families of such persons, are not eligible to enter this competition or to win prizes. "Immediate Family" of a person means the parents, siblings, children and spouse or partner (whether legal or de facto) of that person.
6. "Excluded Customers" of the NZRB are not eligible to win prizes.
7. To be eligible for entry, customers must reside in NZ and be over 18 years of age. The NZRB reserves the right to require any customer to produce identification and/or proof of age and residency.
8. The winning customer will win:
  - \$1000 (in total) worth of bets to be placed on any race at the Riccarton meeting on 5 November 2011, 9 November 2011 or 12 November 2011.
  - There is a maximum of 5 bets to be placed in total.
  - Bets are totalisator only (that is NO fixed odds) and will be placed by an NZRB representative through a TAB Account set up for the purpose on behalf of the winner.
  - All winning dividends will be transferred to the winner within 5 days of the final bet being resulted.
9. There is only one Prize available.
10. If the Prize (or part of any Prize) is unavailable for any reason, NZRB, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the Prize (or part of the Prize) with a prize to the equal monetary value. The Prize, or any unused portion of the Prize, is not transferable and cannot be exchanged for alternative products or services or redeemed for cash.
11. A random draw from all eligible entries will be made at 10am on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October in the presence of designated NZRB representatives. The final decision in respect of any winning entry will be at the sole discretion of the NZRB and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. Winners will be contacted after the draw by telephone. If the NZRB is unable to contact the winning customer by 5pm on Monday 31 October having made reasonable efforts to do so, the winner's entry will be declared invalid and the NZRB reserves the right to randomly redraw another winner on the same terms and conditions as the original draw.
13. The NZRB reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants and to disqualify any customer who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions, or who tampers with the entry process or attempts to act in a fraudulent or dishonest manner, as ineligible to participate in the competition.

To be eligible to claim his or her prize, a winner must first agree to the use of his/her name, place of residence, image and photograph(s), by NZRB and/or any participating company running a competition, for publicity and promotional purposes, without compensation, and agrees to make himself/herself reasonably available for

- publicity photographs and filming. NZRB will own copyright in any such images and photograph(s) and in all material incorporating the photograph(s) or film.
15. If this competition cannot be run as planned for reasons beyond the control of the NZRB, the NZRB reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this competition.

Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the NZRB and any person in connection with this competition are not liable for any direct, indirect, special or consequential loss or damage whatsoever suffered or personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with (i) participation in this competition; (ii) the Prize or use of the Prize; and (iii) the administration of this competition and distribution of the Prize.
  17. Failure by NZRB to enforce any of its rights under these Terms & Conditions at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
  18. The personal information provided by each customer in entering this competition will be held in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993.
  19. The NZRB will not sell, disclose or distribute the personal information provided by customers to any person, organisation, agency or other third party. Customers may request access to their information or may request their information be removed from the database by contacting the NZRB.
  20. NZRB is not responsible for any costs, expenses or losses incurred by the winner in the use of this prize or any other event occurs which is beyond the control of the NZRB and causes further expense to be incurred. The winner will be liable for any such further expense.
