

Christmas at the Races Decorate and Win Competition

Get into the Christmas spirit by decorating your own mini marquee! Simply include some form of Lindauer branding into your display, be judged the best decorated mini marquee at the event, and go into the draw to win two magnums of Lindauer Special Reserve Blanc de Blanc. The best of the best will also win a case of Lindauer Special Reserve Blanc de Blanc, delivered just in time for Christmas.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS –.

1. The Competition opens at noon on Saturday November 14th and closes at 5pm on Sunday December 20th (the **Competition Period**).
2. All customers hiring mini marquees at Christmas at the Races events are eligible to enter. Entry forms will be handed out at each event. There can only be one entry per mini marquee (or group of mini marquees where they are joined together).
3. To enter, customers must decorate their mini marquee in a Christmas theme. Any decorations may be brought onto the course and used to decorate the marquee so long as the decorations are tasteful, do not exceed the perimeter of the marquee, do not annoy neighbouring marquees, do not mark or damage the mini-marquee in any way, and are fully removed within 1 hour after the last race. The display must incorporate some form of Lindauer branding.
4. Decorations may be affixed to the marquee using string, ribbon, blue-tack, Command adhesive or clear-sellotape only. Duct tape, brown tape, glue, staples, Velcro dots, tacks, pins or anything that punctures, marks or damages the marquee or its walls may not be used. The customer may be charged for any damage done to the marquee.
5. Decorations must be fully removed from the mini-marquee within 1 hour after the last race.
6. Board members, employees, agents (and agent's employees) and contractors of the New Zealand Racing Board (**NZRB**) and the Immediate Families of such persons, are not eligible to enter this Competition or to win prizes. "Immediate Family" of a person means the parents, siblings, children and spouse or partner (whether legal or de facto) of that person.
7. To be eligible for entry, Customers must reside in New Zealand and be over 18 years of age. The NZRB reserves the right to require any customer to produce identification and/or proof of age.
8. The winning entry will win 2 magnums of Lindauer Special Reserve Blanc de Blanc (the **Prize**). There is only one Prize available per each CATR event. The Prize is not transferable or convertible for other alternatives and cannot be exchanged for cash.
9. The mini marquees will be judged between races 2 and 3 at each event and the judge will be determined by the NZ Racing Board or the Club.
10. Magnum winners from all the CATR events will go forward to a final judging. The best of the best will win one case (12 bottles) Lindauer Special Reserve Blanc de Blanc.
11. The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. If there is any dispute after the competition, in respect of any winning entry, the decision on that

dispute will be at the sole discretion of the Head of Legal, Risk & Audit of the NZRB and no correspondence will be entered into.

12. At the Christmas at the Races event on Saturday 5th December the Prize will be an equivalent value of Nobile wine.
13. Excluded customers of NZRB are not eligible to win prizes.
14. The NZRB takes no responsibility for loss, damaged or any direct or indirect loss suffered by the winner as part of the Competition or the Prize.
15. The NZRB reserves the right to disqualify any customer from tampering with the entry process or attempting to act in a fraudulent or dishonest manner.
16. The winner agrees to be involved in any reasonable promotional activities stipulated by the NZRB, including but not limited to photographs and the publication of the winners' name(s).
17. If this Competition is unable to be run as planned for any reason, the NZRB reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel this Competition.
18. The NZRB is not liable for any direct, indirect, special or consequential loss or damage caused by the Winner in relation to the Prize or this Competition.
19. The personal information provided by each customer in entering this Competition will be held in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993. The personal information will be stored on a database and may be used only by the NZRB for the purpose of direct mail campaigns to inform customers of promotions and upcoming events.
20. The NZRB will not sell, disclose or distribute the personal information provided by customers to any person, organisation, agency or other third party. Customers may request access to their information or may request their information be removed from the database by contacting the New Zealand Racing Board.
