TAB Cancellation Rule Change

The TAB announced today that as from Monday, June 4, customers will have 120 seconds to cancel their win, place, each-way and quinella bets placed within 30 minutes of the jump for all races delivered by the New Zealand Racing Board.

In making the announcement New Zealand Racing Board Chief Executive, Graeme Hansen said "this change provides customers with extra time in the crucial minutes leading into a race to check and cancel tickets if necessary.

"We emphasise that it is still critical for customers to check all tickets, regardless of bet type, or it could lead to disappointment".

The introduction of the 120 Second Cancellation Rule is one of a number of rule changes gazetted by the New Zealand Racing Board which relate to the placement of bets that will come into effect on Monday, June 4, 2007.
