Refund on Race 11 at Omakau on 2 January 2008

The New Zealand TAB will refund bets on the unplaced runners in Race 11 at Omakau on 2 January 2008. The TAB had correctly listed the race as a 2000 metre event however it was incorrectly run over 2600 metres.

The Harness Racing New Zealand stipendiary stewards enquired into the race and confirmed the placings as declared at the time. However, the New Zealand TAB will provide the opportunity for those TAB customers who bet on the unplaced runners to be refunded due to the confusion on the distance of the race.

For account holders the TAB will make an adjustment for the bets on the unplaced runners. For customers who did not retain the ticket a lost ticket claim should be submitted detailing the bet, the location where the bet was placed and any other bets made at the same time. If a customer has retained the ticket on the unplaced runner please forward to the following address with contact details to make a claim:
